It's great to be back at Bromyard for our 18th year! As usual we have a great selection of beers and ciders from Herefordshire and beyond.

We have an excellent selection of darker beers, from Hobson's award-winning Championship Mild, to Ledbury Dark and Hung Drawn and Double Portered from North Cotswold brewery. You might recall the Hung, Drawn and Double Portered has a full bottle of port added to each cask – delicious/dangerous! If that wasn't quite enough, we have Wye Valley's delicious stout and Titanic's legendary Plum Porter. All are on limited supply so get in early to avoid disappointment.

For this year we're pleased to welcome back beers from Ledbury brewery, alongside some firm favourites from Wye Valley and some interesting seasonals from Teme Valley & Hop Shed.

All bar one of our ciders and perries come from Worcestershire or Herefordshire, with the welcome return of Oliver's made less than 20 minutes from Bromyard.

Our bar will also be offering draught low alcohol cider and lager, along with a range of other bottled and canned lo/no beers.

We're providing a bar again at the Hop Pole Square. The Prancing Pony Horsebox bar is open Saturday and Sunday daytimes 11- 5.30pm.

Brewer	Ale	ABV%	Style	Description
Black Sheep	Bitter	3.8	Amber	Bold, refreshing bitterness at the fore, leading to complex malt and grassy hop flavours. Eminently supple.
Hobsons	Mild	3.2	Dark	A smooth character and taste, notes of chocolate malt gives this beer plenty of flavour and aroma. Previous CAMRA Champion Beer of Britain.
Hobsons	Town Crier	4.5	Gold	A beer to shout about, a most popular crisp full-flavoured golden ale brewed with British hops.
Hopshed	Frizzle IPA	4.5	Pale	A truly British IPA, rich, golden with a floral hop aroma. A slight malty presence, followed by a significant hoppy bitterness from UK Cascade hops.
Hopshed	Green hop	4.1	Green	Brewed with fresh hops straight from the bine, before drying, to give a unique, fresh taste. This brew has used Goldings hops to add gentle honey notes.
Hopshed	Squeeze the Day	3.4	Red	A zesty trio of British hops - Admiral, Godiva, and First Gold - deliver natural orange flavour characteristics. Refreshing, citrusy, and very moreish!
Ledbury	Bitter	3.8	Copper	Traditional copper color with a bitter start, brewed with Herefordshire Admiral and Progress hops, finishing with subtle spice.
Ledbury	Dark	3.9	Dark	Chocolate and coffee notes lead to a smooth finish, with Herefordshire hops (First Gold, Admiral, Goldings) and hints of spice, marmalade, and honey.
Ledbury	Gold	4	Gold	Made using two Herefordshire hops (First Gold and Fuggles). A golden bitter with a malt and hop combination that ensures it is well balanced with a honey and fruit finish.

Purity	Mad Goose	3.5	Pale VE GF	Zesty pale ale with a smooth and citrusy finish. English Maris Otter, Caragold and Wheat malts, Hallertau Northern Brewer bittering hops + Cascade and Willamette aroma hops.	
Salopian	Golden Thread	5 	Gold	A bright gold ale, using wheat and lager malt and flavoured with an infusion of aroma hops. Clean and crisp to the palate with a hint of sweetness and a long fruit filled finish.	
Salopian	Lemon Dream	4.5	Special	A shimmering golden ale that is brewed using organic lemons which adds beautifully subtle zesty aromas and a citrus filled fruity finish.

Abrahall's Herefordshire	Dry	6	Dry	A well rounded, easy to drink, dry cider, made from 100% cider apples - a blend of bitter sweet and sharp – Dabinett, Michelin and a smattering of Kingston Black, the old cidermaker's favourite.	
Abrahall's Herefordshire	Medium	6	Medium	Well-rounded and easy drinking, made from bittersweet and sharp cider apples – Dabinett, Michelin and Kingston Black - that are allowed to fully ripen bringing out a full flavour.	
Barkers Worcestershire	BBC Dry	7	Dry	Will suit those who like a strong Dry cider. Aroma is woody and has some barnyard and yeast too. It's tart but fruity and refreshing. From a restored traditional orchard near Worcester.	
Barkers Worcestershire	BBC Medium Dry	6.8	Medium Dry	Traditional cider, celebrating 25years of cider making at Greenstreet Farm. Full of flavour, 2022 vintage, clear and bright.	
Barkers Worcestershire	Victorian Orchard Perry	6.5	Perry	Made from pear trees planted in 1850. Made the traditional way in Worcestershire, clear and tasty.	
Celtic Marches Herefordshire	Alice	4.6	Medium	Medium well rounded yet a little tart. A customer has described it as 'Great mouth feel and a lot going on on the flavour front' – you're onto a winner!
